This Indenture made this 12th day of March in the year of our Lord
one thousand eight hundred and twenty two between Edward Pettit and Elias
Summerall of the County of Southampton of the one part and Robert Mourant
of the same County of the other part. Whereas by a decree entered in the
County Court of Southampton held at the Court House on the 18 day of July
last past (1822) in the cause therein lately depending between John
Vergheant plaintiff and William Sinkins John Whitefield and Lucy
his wife Mary Lynalting Stacey Sinkins Policy Sinkins widow
and eldest of John Sinkins Edward Sinkins Elias Sinkins Policy
Sinkins and Sinkins defendants it was decreed and ordered that
the said Edward Pettit and Elias Summerall trustees named in the Decree
of Trust in the plaintiffs like mentioned should at Public Auction
for ready money make sale of a certain Tract of Land in the said
County mentioned after advertising the time and place of sale for twenty
days and out of the proceeds of said Sale pay to the plaintiff
The sum of
