

their discretion and giving ten days notice thereof and out of the money arising from such sale shall after satisfying thereof and all other expenses attending the same pay to the said Samuel Parrett his heirs executors or assigns the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars and ten cents with the interest which may thereunto lawfully have accrued the balance paid to the said Littleberry Jones his heirs executors or assigns but if the whole of the said sum of one hundred and thirty dollars and ten cents with interest or assigns on or before the twenty fifth day of December next when the same is payable so that no default of the payment of the sum of one hundred and thirty dollars and ten cents be made then this Indenture to be void or else to remain in full force and virtue

This Indenture made this nineteenth day of June and in the Year eighteen hundred and twenty two between Benjamin C Hancock and Nancy his wife of the County of Southampton of the one part and Thomas Hatchen of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin C Hancock and Nancy his wife for and in consideration of the sum of fifty Dollars lawful money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Hatchen at or before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Thomas Hatchen his heirs and assigns a certain parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and on the north side of round Hill Swamp and bounded as followeth to wit by the hands of Richard P Stiles Patrick Pond and Deloach do being the same land purchased by Benjamin Haistey from Patrick Pond the bounds well more fully appear by reference to Four Deeds to Haistey containing by estimation fifty acres be the same more or less together with all & singular the appurtenances and Executions and what was to the
