This Indenture made this 25th day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and thirty Benjamin Cobb and Susanna his wife of the one part and John Williams of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Cobb and Susanna his wife in consideration of the sum of five hundred dollars in hand paid have granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said John Williams and he has a certain tract or parcel of land situated lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and on the west side of the apomaroose Swamp and in the forks of said Swamp and abutting upon Rivin containing by estimation fifty acres in the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a black gum on the side of the road from the Barre Tavern to the apomaroose bridge ^{leading} thence down the road to a pine stump thence to a black gum in George Hobbs line thence a line of marked trees to a white oak a corner of George Hobbs and the land formerly the property of Elias Hobbs decd from thence a line of marked trees to a scrub white oak a corner in George Hobbs line from thence
