This Indenture made this 14th day of September in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two between William Calvert of the one part and Samuel Calvert of the other part the former of the Town of Petersburg and the latter of Jerusalem and State of Virginia Witnesseth that for and consideration of the sum of two hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Samuel Calvert the receipt whereof the said William Calvert doth hereby acknowledge hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain sell unto the said Samuel Calvert all his right title interest claims or demand of and unto the certain undivided tract or parcels of Land containing two hundred and seventy six and one half acres situated lying and being in the County of Southampton which said Land was purchased by Samuel Calvert Esq. of a certain Richard Vick and bounded as is expressed in a deed of Conveyance executed by the said Richard Vick to the said Samuel Calvert &c. referred being thereof had well make the same more fully appear to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land unto the said Samuel Calvert his heirs or assigns with
