Turgason of the same County State and Parish of the other part witnesseth that the said Alfred Story and George his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Sixty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Sept. Turgason at and before the sealing and delivering of these presents the receipt whereof they the said Alfred Story and George his wife doth hereby acknowledge themselves fully satisfied Contented & paid have bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and forever confirm unto him the said Sept. Turgason his heirs and assigns a certain meadow plantation tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being in the parish aforesaid containing — acres & being all the right title interest claims and estate in fee simple and all other of them the said Alfred Story and George his wife in all the Lands of Josiah Turgason decd. which they the said Alfred Story and George his wife then their heirs or assigns may ever claim in said Lands together with all houses and house gardens and ways waters and water courses wood underwood mine minerals and all other the profits and commodities thereto belonging or in anywise appurtenant to have and to hold the said bargained premises with the appurtenances unto the said Sept. Turgason his heirs and assigns forever with the reversion and reversions remainders and remainders unto heirs and profits and every part
