This Indenture made this the twenty first day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two by and between Alfred Stong and Dacey his wife of the County of Southampton and state of Virginia and in the lower district of Saint Lukes Parish of the one part and Josiah Tice of the same County State and Parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Alfred Stong and Dacey his wife for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars to them in hand paid by the said Josiah Tice at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof they the said Alfred Stong and Dacey his wife doth hereby acknowledge themselves fully satisfied Contented and paid have bargained sold aliend enfeoffed and Confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain sell aliend enfeoff and forever Confirm unto him the said Josiah Tice his heirs and assigns a certain Tract or parcel of land situate lying and being in the County and Parish aforesaid containing by survey thirty two acres be the same more or less bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a small white oak a corner of said Tract and Benjamin Jordan in said Tice's line thence a little east of South by the said said Tice's line to a gum a corner of Echem Tice's and said said Tice's thence running nearly the same course by the said Echem Tice's line to a Pine a corner of Jacob Barnes thence by the said Barnes line nearly a west course to the Cypress road thence crossing said Road to Sally Whores line thence by the said Whores line to a pine a corner in said Whores line thence North by the said Whores line to a pine a corner of Samuel Tice's thence a little North of east to a small red oak by the side of said Road thence the various courses of said Road to Rhoulin Whitefield's line to a poplar gum thence nearly East by said Whitefield's line to a pine to a stub thence by said Whitefield's line to a pine
