This Indenture made on the fifteenth day of June 1801 one thousand eight hundred and twenty two Between Hardy Rand and Elizabeth his wife of the one part and Littleton Moore of the other part all of Southampton County Virginia Witnesseth that the said Hardy Rand and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of seventy five dollars to them for hand paid by the said Littleton Moore at or before the enrolling and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Hardy Rand and Elizabeth his wife hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Littleton Moore his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton marked and bounded as follows beginning at a Plum Standing in the old County line a corner of Lawrence Parsonage
