This Indenture made this 13th day of September in the Year of our Lord Church one thousand eight hundred and twenty two between Robert Murray of the County of Southampton of the one part and Zebulon Eley of the said County of the other part Witnesseth that the said Robert Murray for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred and fifty dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Zebulon Eley the receipt whereof I do here acknowledge I the said Robert Murray hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Zebulon Eley his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land and premises situate lying and being in the County of Southampton (formerly the property of Valentino Jenkins dec'd.) and bounded by the lands of Peter Bursell Simon Boylston Daniel Boylston late Sons Robert Mercer William Borden Lucy Brooks Samuel Stephenson and John Borden containing by a late survey five hundred and sixty acres more or less together with all houses out houses and appurtenances therunto belonging To have and to hold the said Land and premises to him and his heirs forever and the said Robert Murray for himself his heirs &c. doth by these presents Covenant and grant to and with the said Zebulon Eley that he the said Robert Murray against all persons claiming by or through him the aforesaid tract of Land will forever warrant and defend And Witness whereof the said Robert Murray hath hereunto set his hand and seal affixed his seal the day and Year above written Signed Sealed and delivered
