This Indenture made and entered into this 16th day of September 1822
Between Thomas E. Brook and Polly his wife of the first part (Baldy
Drake and Lucy Brook of the second part and Arthur Abidolton
mutually chosen as trustee by the parties of the third part) Witnesseth
that Whereas the said Baldy Drake and Lucy Brook has this
day bound as security for the said Thomas E. Brook (his own behavior
by recognizance entered into in open Court conditioned as the Law
directs in the penalty of two hundred dollars. Now therefore of the said
Baldy Drake and Lucy Brook shall or either of them suffer by
reason of the securityship aforesaid or shall be likely to suffer then
and in that case it shall be lawful for the said Arthur Abidolton
to sell at Publick Sale after giving reasonable Publick notice thereof
the tract of Land wherein the said Thomas E. Brook and Polly his
wife now lives lying and being in the County of Southampton contain-
ing by estimation One hundred and thirty seven acres together with
the Crop of Corn and Fodder now on the plantation being the
present Crop and out of the proceeds thereof pay all such sums
as he is legally bound to pay by these presents and the surplus if
any return to the said Thomas E. Brook and Polly his wife -
Now This Indenture further Witnesseth that for and in consid-
eration of the Circumstances aforesaid as well for and in consid-
eration of the Sum of one dollar to them the said Thomas
E. Brook and Polly his wife paid by the said Arthur Abidolton
(as trustee) the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge
hath granted bargained sold and Conveyed and by these
presents do grant bargain sell and Convey unto the said
Arthur Abidolton as Trustee the aforesaid tract of Land
Containing One hundred and thirty seven acres of Land be-
the same more or less together with the Crop of Corn and Fodder
now growing (or hath grown this Year) on the said tract of
Land for the special purpose as heretofore expressed or to be
expressed. And the said Thomas E. Brook and Polly
his wife do hereby Convey unto the said Arthur Abidolton
as Trustee aforesaid the aforesaid tract of Land and Crop of
Corn and Fodder To have and to hold the aforesaid tract
of Land and Crop of Corn and Fodder unto him the
said Abidolton his heirs and assigns forever as heretofore
directed and the said Brook and wife do hereby warrant
