This Indenture made and entered into the 23rd day of February in the year
of our Lords Christ eighteen hundred and twenty two Robert Abnerle clerk of the County
of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and James Tillan of the County of Green
ville and State aforesaid of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said Robert Abnerle
is indebted to Lewis Dupree the sum of ten hundred and twenty two dollars and ten cents due
by bond on demand this day and bearing date accordingly also the said Abnerle is indebted
to Lewis Dupree Executor of Captain Thomas Williamson the sum of one hundred and twenty seven
dollars and twenty two cents due by bond on demand this day and bearing date accordingly
one other bond due to E. Abnerle with the said Lewis Dupree security there for the sum of fifty
dollars on demand the 1st day of November eighteen hundred and twenty and bearing date
the twenty sixth of October in the same year also one other bond to Arthur Tice with the said Lewis
Dupree security there for fifty dollars bearing date the day of _____ and on demand the day
of _____ also one other bond to William Francis with the said Lewis Dupree security
there for the sum of One hundred dollars bearing date the day of _____ and on demand
the day of _____ also one other bond due to Aaron T. Smith bearing date the
fourteenth day of February eighteen hundred and twenty one for one hundred dollars
with interest thereon from the date thereof And whereas the said Robert Abnerle is indebted
to Lewis Dupree the sum of ten hundred and twenty two dollars and ten cents due by bond on demand
this day and bearing date accordingly also the said Lewis Dupree also the debt due from
as Executor of Capt Thomas Williamson as well as for the several debts above recited
for which he is security and the said Robert Abnerle being moved upon and induced from
the consideration of the premises and moreover for and in consideration of the sum of one
dollar to him paid by James Tillan the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
have given granted bargained and sold unto the said Lewis Tillan his heirs Executors adm^r &
assigns the following negro slaves namely Albany Munnah Gary and Finchen and
their future increase severethelp in trust for the purpose of paying all the above
recited debts interest and costs and the said James Tillan being justly acquit
thereof by either of the parties shall make sale of the said negroes for cash or so
many thereof as may be required at the residence of said Abnerle or any other
place agree on by the parties having first advertised the sale ten days previous
therein at the Court House of Greenville County and at _____ more publick places
in the said County and in the County of Southampton and the money arising
from such sale or sales to be applied in the first place to pay the legal charges
of the sale and drawing and according to this Indenture and secondly
to pay the above recited debts interest and costs and the surplus if any
to be paid to the said Robert Abnerle his heirs Executors adm^r or assigns in
Witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my hand and seal the day
and date above written
