This Indenture made and entered into this 22<sup>nd</sup> day of February in the year  
of our Lord Christ eighteen hundred and twenty two between Robert Burnell esq; of the County of Green-  
ville and State of Virginia of the one part and James Tilcar of the County of Green-  
ville and State of Virginia of the other part witnesseth that whereas the said Robert Burnell  
doth owe unto the said James Tilcar the sum of ten thousand and twenty two dollars and ten cents due  
to him by bond to Lewis Draper the sum of one thousand and twenty two dollars and ten cents due  
by bond or demand this day and bearing date accordingly also the said Burnell doth owe  
to James Draper Esq; of Captain Stover Williamson the sum of one thousand and twenty two  
dollars and twenty two cents due by bond on demand this day and bearing date accordingly  
one other bond due C. Martin with the said James Draper security therefor for the sum of fifty  
Dollars on demand at the 1<sup>st</sup> day of November eighteen hundred and twenty one bearing date  
the twenty ninth of October in the same year also one other bond to another man with the said Lewis  
Draper security therefor fifty dollars bearing date the day of ~~and on demand the day~~  
also one other bond to Martin Francis with the said Lewis Draper security  
therefor the sum of One thousand dollars bearing date the day of ~~and on demand~~  
the day of ~~also one other bond due to me from R. Smith bearing date the~~  
~~seventh day of February eighteen hundred and twenty one for one hundred dollars~~  
~~with interest thereon from the date hereof And Whereas the said Robert Burnell is willing to~~  
~~desire of securing the payment of the debt due the said Lewis Draper also the debt due him~~  
~~as creditor of Capt Stover Williamson as aforesaid for the several debts above recited~~  
~~for which he is security and the said Robert Burnell being moved thereto and induced from~~  
~~the consideration of the promises and moreover for and in consideration of the sum of one~~  
~~dollar to him paid by James Tilcar the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged~~  
~~to have given granted bargained and sold unto the said James Tilcar his Heirs Execs adms &c to~~  
~~abide the following negro slaves namely Albany Almonah Blazy and Stechon and~~  
~~their future increase forever to help in trust for the purpose of paying all the above~~  
~~recited debts interest and costs and the said James Tilcar being first required~~  
~~thereto by either of the parties shall make sale of the said negroes for cash or so~~  
~~many thereof as may be required at the residence of said Burnell or any other~~  
~~place agreed on by the parties having first advertised the sale ten days previous~~  
~~thirtieth at the Court House of Greenville County and at three more publick places~~  
~~in the said County and in the County of Southampton and the money arising~~  
~~from such sale or sales to be applied in the first place to pay the legal charg-  
es of the sale and drawing and recording this Indenture and secondly~~  
~~to pay the aforesaid debts interest and costs and the surplus if any~~  
~~to be paid to the said Robert Burnell the sum execs adms & agent be-  
ing witness whereof I have hereunto affixed my Hand and Seal the day~~
