 the other part each of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the
 Salathiel Francis for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand eight hundred and
 eighty five and a half cents to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Moore the receipt whereof
 the said Salathiel Francis doth hereby acknowledge He the said Salathiel Francis doth bargain
 sell alien and confirm unto the said Thomas Moore his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Lands containing by
 late survey acres be the same more or less of being part of the lands from
 and or records well fully shown the boundaries together with all and singular the rights liberties &
 appurtenances thereto belonging and the services and remainders of the same and purport thereof to have
 to hold the said tract or parcel of Lands unto the said Thomas Moore his heirs and assigns forever
 or intended to be with them and every of their heirs and assigns and assigns to the only proper use of
 the said Thomas Moore and his heirs forever and the said Salathiel Francis his heirs heirs executors
 and former defend the premises aforesaid unto the said Thomas Moore his heirs and assigns forever
