Rochelle of the second part and James D Delaponting of the third part Whereas the said Thomas C Jones is party first to the said James D Delaponting
in the sum of three hundred and dollars more or less and is willing to purchase the said James D Delaponting with their families and carrying out from the said James
with the said Thomas C Jones is willing and desirous to secure as aforesaid to the said James D Delaponting complete indemnity against any of the said
James to be liable to secure as aforesaid the said Thomas C Jones or which the said James D Delaponting shall be liable for by reason of an engagement for the payment of
money either directly or collaterally And for and in consideration of the premises and the further covenants hereinafter made to the said Thomas C Jones on the 15th
part by the said James Rochelle This Indenture witnesseth that he the said Thomas C Jones hath given granted bargained sold and by these presents
delivered and begun deliverance in full and confirm with the said James Rochelle his heirs and assigns forever a part of Land containing one hundred
and twenty five part of the lands on which he now resides and bounded by the residence of his brother the owner of Little Neck Creek Effingham Mills Crooked
and James Delaponting also the following personal Estate to wit the whole of his house hold furniture consisting of the bed and feathered
mattress and bed case Pillows and Chairs one fine Mass one double Chaise and four new with wheel and carriage The appurtenances to the said
part of Land belonging or on any way appertaining To have and to hold the said part of Land and premises with its appurtenances together
with the aforesaid personal property being conveyed unto the said James Rochelle his heirs and assigns forever Upon these premises and conditions that
