 house hold and kitchen furniture and plantation utensils with every other species of property now owned by and in the possession
 of him the said Edwin Cropley or that may hereafter in any manner be acquired by and brought into his possession at any
 time during the pendency of the present trust together with the crops to be made on the plantation now occupied by the said
 Edwin Cropley the present year and also and every future crop of every kind by him to be raised on the said
 plantation for and during the term for which he hath leased the same or until the object of the present trust
 is fully answered or until he secure certain debt due and owing from the said Edwin Cropley to the said Edmund
