household and give & bids and furniture 3 Head of cattle 3 iron pots & tea kettle one frying pan & teale one
gun & scythes 2 axes & smoothing box 2 plan boxes & pair braces all the Crockery ware and all other
house hold and kitchen furniture and plantation articles with every other species of property now owned by and in the possession
of them the said Edwin Brufkin or that may hereafter in any manner be acquired by and brought into his possession always
true during the pendency of this present trial together with the right to be made on the plantation now occupied by the said
Edwin Brufkin the present year and all and every future crop of every kind by him to be raised on the said
plantation for and during the time for which he hath leased the same or until the end of this present trial
is fully answered in order to secure certain debts due according from the said Edwin Brufkin to the said Leman
