This Indenture made this 20th day of November in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two Between Richard H. Shaw of the one part and Henry King of the other part Witnesseth that the said Richard H. Shaw for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty three dollars and thirty three and 1/2 Cents by the said Henry King to the said Richard H. Shaw in hand paid as on before the entry and delivery of these presents through the hands of a Justice of the Peace as is here granted hereinafter as is set out by these presents as great bargain and contentment the said Henry King by these presents doth give unto the said Richard H. Shaw a certain tract or parcel of Land situate in the Town of Southampton being part of the tract which the said Henry King and his heirs purchased of James Lee and then set to lots numbered fifty commencing at the East West track and bounded as follows To wit Beginning at the post at the line of the lot purchased by John Shaw of 17 from the ground upon which stands a large white oak in a branch there the lot is first to a double cross'd pine in the edge of another branch then to a large pine a corner of the Land formerly owned by Captain T. H. purchased from Captain Scott from thence about thirty or forty yards further to a large flowering pine corner of the same Land thence nearly a right angle to a cross to a large gum tree a slash from thence up the side of the slash to a low oak a corner two feet from thence a straight line over a right angle to the upper corner forming William White Lot from thence along the back line forming White Lot Doctor Moore J. S. William Beckman Lot and Richard Shaw Lot to the first station which corner was supposed some time off to cut over two acres the the same corner of the lot of the said Henry King in the town of Southampton of 17-19 formerly owned by John Shaw White To have unto to hold the said Land and Lots above described and being intended to be granted and sold with all its appurtenances together with all their contents and everything touching or in any way concerning the same to the said Henry King his heirs and assigns forever and the said Richard H. Shaw his heirs to the said tract and parcel of Land and Lots hereinafter to be granted and sold with the appurtenances unto them the said Henry King his heirs and assigns against all and every other person or persons claiming by force or power here or shall not well warrant and forever defend In testimony whereof the said Richard H. This Indenture made this 21st day of October one thousand eight hundred and twenty two Between William (Wife of the County of Southampton of one part and Elizabeth Bryant of William of the other part Witnesseth that the said William Took for and in consideration of the sum of five dollars in hand paid by the said Elizabeth Bryant of William the receipt being duly acknowledged that hereinafter as is set out by these presents doth give unto the said Elizabeth Bryant of William and to her heirs forever one certain tract and parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton aforesaid and in parish of Saint Peter and being part of the Land which James Lee owned at a settlement two with its hereditaments together with all rights title profits and without which the said William Took has hereunto may have in right to the said tract and parcel of Land unto the said Elizabeth Bryant of William and her heirs forever to the sole proper use and behoof of her the said Elizabeth Bryant of William and the said William Took for himself his heirs and assigns forever and defend the title of the aforesaid tract and parcel of Land and every part thereof against all and every person or persons whatsoever In testimony whereof the said William Took hereunto set his hand and seal the day and year above written
