This Indenture made the eightenth day of October in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty two between Spencer Sackm of the first part James Bishop and Thomas Bishop of the second part and Bennett Edwards of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesses that whereas the said Spencer Sackm stands justly indebted to the said James Bishop and Thomas Bishop in the sum of twenty three dollars and fifty seven Cents by Note bearing date the day of said date above mentioned, On demands with interest thereon from the said Sheriff and the said James Sackm being willing and desirous to secure the payment of the aforesaid sum of money with the interest accruing thereon to the said James Bishop as well for and consideration of the premises aforesaid as for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to him in hand paid by the said Bennett Edwards the said James Bishop doth hereby acknowledge both grants bargain wthole and by these here and assigns forever the following property to wit one horse Cart and wheels two leather boots and furniture two chest three ^{one plate} ~~one~~ and eight sitting chairs one table one iron spinning wheel ten pair one pyring pan one tin tub one iron skillet one tin that given one case one spinning fork one silver earthen plate three dishes one still cups and saucers two silver vases one dozen of tea spoons which said property is now in the possession of said Spencer Sackm to the said Bennett Edwards his heirs and assigns forever Nevertheless upon this express condition that if the said Spencer Sackm shall not and lawfully pay or cause to be paid unto the said James Bishop and Thomas Bishop the aforesaid sum of twenty three dollars fifty seven Cents with the legal interest accruing and all cost incurred in drawing and recording this present writing when he shall thereto be required then and in that case it shall be lawful and it is hereby agreed to by all parties to these presents that the said Bennett Edwards may and shall execute a full and complete deed of release and do all other acts which counsel learned in the Law may advise for the purpose recovering the said property unto the said Spencer Sackm his heirs Executors or administrators said or assign to pay the aforesaid sum of money with the interest and cost aforesaid or any part thereof whereunto required then and in that case it is hereby agreed between the parties that it may be lawful for the said Bennett Edwards who is mutually chosen by the parties as trustee his Executors or administrators at the request of either the said Spencer Sackm or the said James or Thomas Bishop or either of their heirs or administrators to expose the aforesaid property to Publick sale for cash or so much thereof as will pay and satisfy the aforesaid sum of money interest and costs after first giving ten days notice by advertisement at the first day of the next Session of Court in the County of Southampton of the time and place of sale and out of the proceeds thereof pay and satisfy the aforesaid debt interest and costs and the surplus if any pay to the said Spencer Sackm his heirs Executors or administrators and it is further agreed between the parties that it may be lawful for the said Bennett Edwards in case a sale to execute a full and complete deed of conveyance conveying the fee simple estate of said property to the purchaser or purchasers and the said Spencer Sackm for himself his heirs Executors or assigns hereby covenants and agrees to and with the said Bennett Edwards his heirs Executors or assigns that he the said Spencer Sackm for himself his heirs Executors and against all one person or persons whomsoever do testify and confirm the parties to these presents have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day and date first above written
