This Indenture made this 21st day of October 1722 Between Samuel Carden and wife Martha Carden Mary Wells all of the County of Westberd and State of North Carolina of the one part and William Allens of the County of Surry and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Samuel Carden and wife Martha Carden Mary Wells for and in consideration of the sum of twelve hundred and ninety six dollars to them in hand paid by the said William Allens before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt & payment they do hereby acknowledge and sheweth to be thorough fully paid: as contented and paid: Have granted bargain'd sold alien'd assign'd and confirm'd unto the said presents do grant bargain'd sell alien and confirm unto him the said William Allen all the said Samuel Cardens and wife Martha Carden Mary Wells right title interest claim or demand in and to a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia being the tract of Land which fell to the said Martha Carden wife of Samuel Carden by the death of her father John Carden's certain by limitation three hundred and twenty five acres be the same more or less and bounded as follow Beginning at a Red oak standing in the Road leading from the road into the swampy low and at corner of the said William Allen running thence along a line of marked trees to the head of a small branch thence down the various courses of the cur of said branch to where it intersect with the poplar swamp thence up the various courses of the cur of said poplar swamp to where the said William Allens line intersects the said swamp near a large poplar standing in the run of said swamp thence along said Allen line of marked trees to a white oak corner tree of the said Allen thence along a line of marked trees between the said Allen and Thomas Howells trees to the first Station To have and to hold the said bargain'd premises hereby conveyed to him the said William Allen his heirs and assigns forever together with all and singular the appurtenances profits and Emoluments to the same in any manner belonging or in anywise appertaining unto they and they the said Samuel Carden and wife Martha Carden Mary Wells do hereby for themselves their Executors and Administrators forever covenant and defend a good and perfect right and title to the said Tract of Land herein conveyed to him the said William Allen his heirs and assigns forever In witness whereof they the said Samuel Carden and wife Martha Carden Mary Wells have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals this day and date before mentioned
