This Indenture made the 17th day of October in the year of our Christ one thousand eight hundred and twenty two between Jonathan Suter of the one part and Obblan Suter of the other part both of the County of Southampton and Parish of Netley May, Witneseth that the said Jonathan Suter in consideration of the sum of sixty dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to him in hand paid by the said Obblan Suter or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is truly acknowledged here bargained and sold and by these presents do bargain and sell unto the said Obblan Suter his heirs and assigns one certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County and Parish aforesaid containing by estimation twelve acres be the same more or less of being a piece of Land purchased by the said Jonathan Suter under a deed in trust executed by Richard Blackthorn to Benjamin Clifton to secure the payment of a sum of money due Henry Snow and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a lightwood post a corner in John Stephens line thence the various courses of the road to a lightwood post a corner in Rebecca Suters line thence a line of marked trees to a lightwood post a corner of Jonathan and John Suters line thence a line of marked trees to a lightwood post a corner in John Stephens line thence along the said Stephens line to the first station together with all and singular the houses our houses gardens woods and more or less meadows and water courses privileges profits commodities hereditaments whatsoever to the said Land belonging or in anywise appurtenant as may part or parcel thereof Or here and to hold the said Land with the tenements hereditaments thereto belonging and every part or parcel thereof unto the said Obblan Suter his heirs and assigns forever to and for the use proper use and behoof of him the said Obblan Suter his heirs and assigns forever and the said Jonathan Suter for himself his heirs Executors and Administrators the said Order acres of Land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Obblan Suter his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of him the said Jonathan Suter his heirs Executors or admrs and all and every other person or persons whatever shall and lawfully claim and forever defend by these presents Or notwithstanding the said Jonathan Suter hath received of the said Obblan Suter one seal the day and Year first above written Signed sealed and delivered in presence of
