This Indenture made the 22 day of April in the year of Our Lords one thousand eight hundred and twenty two between Jacob Williams of the County of Southampton of the one part and Nathan Pope of the said County of Southampton part Witnesseth that the said Jacob Williams for and consideration of the sum of ten hundred and sixty five dollars current money of good and lawful gold granted bargained sold and conveyed by these presents unto the said Nathan Pope his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land containing fifty five acres be the same more or less lying and being in the County of Southampton and known by the name of the said hundred as follows to wit beginning at a small red oak a new corner made between Jacob Williams and Thomas Doughty and on Nathan Pope's boundary line thence along Nathan Pope's line 50 yds to a pine a corner of Nathan Pope's near his fence and on the side of a small branch thence North 71 West poles to a spruce on the new thence N 17 W 170 yds to a small hickory a new corner made between Jacob Williams and Thomas Doughty and on John Stephens's thence S 70 E 60 poles to a spruce oak a new corner made between Jacob Williams and Thomas Doughty thence along the dividing line of the said parties S 61 E 112 poles to the first station containing fifty five acres be the same more or less To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances thence belonging to him the said Nathan Pope his heirs and assigns to the only proper use and behoof of the said Nathan Pope his heirs and assigns forever and the said Jacob Williams for himself his heirs and Administrators with heirs covenant and agree to and with the said Nathan Pope his heirs and assigns that the said Jacob Williams and his heirs the said tract or parcel of Land with its appurtenances unto him the said Nathan Pope his heirs and assigns against him the said Jacob Williams and his heirs and against all persons whomsoever shall & in witness whereof the said Jacob Williams hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal the day and Year above written
