This Indenture made this day of September in the year of 1822
between Edmund Williford of Southampton County of his first part, Thomas Priller administra-
tor of Joshua Priller of the second part, and Robert Priller of the third part, all of said
County of Southampton and State of Virginia, Witnesseth that whereas the said Edmund
Williford being justly indebted to Joshua Priller at the time of his death in
the amount of two hundred ninety one dollars and 58 cents by note bearing date the
17th day of April 1822 and being desirous of securing to him the said Thomas
Priller administrator of the said Joshua Priller and to the said Edmund Williford, he had
given granted bargained, sold and confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain
and sell confirm unto the said Robert Priller trustee all my interest in the Land &
plantation whereon I now live which said interest I purchased of my brother Robert
Williford of the part whereon my father John Williford lived and died lying
and being in the County of Southampton and part of it being containing by estimation or its
undivided state one hundred and thirty seven acres be the same more or less one fourth part
being the land herein conveyed as my interest, and to him the said Robert Priller or his representa-
tives forever in trust provided the said Edmund Williford shall pay to the said Thomas Priller or
his assigns the before named sum of two hundred ninety one dollars and fifty six cents with interest &
what cost may accrue in having the said records when thereto required by the said Thomas
Priller administrator of Joshua Priller died or his assigns then their executors shall be well and con-
firmed in the event of failure on the part of the said Edmund Williford to discharge the said debt unless that
then in that case the before named Robert Priller trustee shall when thereto required by the said Thom-
as Priller or his assigns to sell at public sale first giving ten days notice stating all my interest in the
Lands before mentioned, and convey as good and absolute right and title to the said Lands and premises
to the purchaser and if any balance shall remain after paying the debt interest and cost of the sale
such balance if any shall be paid unto the aforesaid Edmund Williford or his representatives

This Indenture made this day of _____ in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred &
twenty between Gershom Samuel and Orville Santford of Southampton County Virginia of the one part and
James White of the other part Witnesseth that whereas the said James White in and more effectually to secure
the payment of a debt due and owing from him to the above named Gershom Samuel as under date the eight
eenth day of August one thousand eight hundred and eighteen being in trust to the said Gershom
Samuel and Orville Santford a certain tract or parcel of Land as appears by a deed duly executed
by the said James White to the said Gershom Samuel and Orville Santford which deed bears date
the 15th of August 1818 as aforesaid and is duly recorded in the County Court of Southamp-
ton and whereas the debt aforesaid is fully paid and discharged and in as much
as the tract due aforesaid was cut for no other end or design than that a solemn contract
Not therefore they the said Gershom Samuel and Orville Santford for themselves
their heirs and assigns have granted bargained released and remised and by these
