This Indenture made this 2nd day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and twenty two Between Sally Francis of the one part and Thomas Moore of the other part each of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnessed that the said Sally Francis for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and forty dollars to her in hand paid by the said Thomas Moore the receipt whereof the said Sally Francis doth hereby acknowledge she doth Sally Francis doth bargain sell alien and Confirm unto the said Thomas Moore his heirs and assigns forever on certain tract or parcel of Lands Containing by late survey two hundred and forty acres be the same more or less of every part of the Lands formerly belonging to Samuel Francis deceased and drawn by William Francis dead at being Lot No 3 for which the Commissioners report or record calls for the boundaries together with all and singular the rights members and appurtenances thereunto belonging and the revenue and profits thereof to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of land and all and singular the premises hereby bargained and sold or mentioned or intended to be sold her and every of her heirs members and assigns to the only proper use of the said Thomas Moore and his heirs forever and the said Sally Francis her heirs and assigns forever against all and every person or persons who shall come to mixt of whom of the said Sally Francis have hereunto set her hand and affixed her seal this day and Year first above written

This Indenture made this 17th day of November one thousand Eight hundred and twenty two Between Egan Bryant of the County of Southampton of one part and Egan Bryant of the said County of the other part Witnessed that the said Egan Bryant for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars to him in hand paid by the said Egan Bryant the receipt is hereby acknowledged hath bargained sold and Conferred unto the said Egan Bryant and to his heirs forever on tract or parcel of Land lying in the County of Southampton of one part and in the parish of Saint Lukes containing by Extenture Two acres and some as follows: Beginning at a black gum standing in the rear of a small branch a new corner of said Egan Bryant on said Egan Bryants line thence along said Egan Bryants line to a corner on Eads Parcells line near a few rods off Eads standing in the rear of the Path a new corner of Egan Bryant thence along the said Eads Parcells line to the rear of a small branch thence down the various courses of the said branch to a black gum standing at the intersection of the two branches New corner of Egan Bryant and Egan Bryant on said Eads Parcells line thence along said Egan Bryants line up the various courses of the first branch to the beginning all the right title &c of in and to the said lands and plantations from the said Egan Bryant to have and to hold the said land and all parcel of lands and premises hereunto appurtenances with the said Egan Bryant and his heirs forever to the only proper use and behoof of the said Egan Bryant and the said Egan Bryant for himself his heirs and assigns forever with power to sell and defend the title of the same and every part thereof against all and every person or persons who shall come to mixt of whom of the said Egan Bryant have hereunto set my hand and affixed my seal this day and Year first above written
