This Indenture made this 15th day of Novr in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
 thirty two between Thomas Moore and Sally his wife of the one part and Salathiel Francis of the other
 part each of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia doth certify that the said Thomas Moore
 and Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Ten thousand and fifty five dollars an
 money cents to them in hand paid by the said Salathiel Francis the receipt whereof the said Thomas
 Moore and Sally his wife doth hereby acknowledge they the said Thomas Moore and Sally
 his wife doth hereby bargain and sell alien and confirm and by these presents doth grant
 bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Salathiel Francis his heirs and assigns forever
 one certain tract or parcel of Lands containing by late survey one hundred and eighty acres of the
 same more or less situate part of the Lands formerly belonging to Samuel Francis Esq.
 and a part of Lot No 1 which Lot was drawn up by Samuel Francis Jr and sold to William Francis
 which deed and the Commissioners report will fully show the boundaries together with all &
 singular the rights members and appurtenances thereto belonging and the reasons of the
 said Salathiel Francis and his heirs forever and the said Thomas Moore and Sally
 his wife warrant and forever defend the premises aforesaid unto the said Salathiel
 Francis his heirs and assigns forever against all and every person or persons whatsoever
 In witness whereof the said Thomas Moore and Sally his wife have then hereunto set
 their hands and affixed their seals the day and date first above written
