This Indenture made this 15th day of Novr in the Year of our Lords one thousand eight hundred and
twenty two between Thomas Moore and Sally his wife of the one part and Salathiel Francis of the other
part each of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia Witnesseth that the said Thomas Moore
and Sally his wife for and in consideration of the sum of Ten hundred and fifty five dollars an
money cents to them in hand paid by the said Salathiel Francis the receipt whereof the said Thomas
Moore and Sally his wife doth hereby acknowledge they the said Thomas Moore and Sally
his wife doth hereby bargain and sell alien and confirm and by these presents doth grant
bargain sell alien and confirm unto the said Salathiel Francis his heirs and assigns forever
one certain tract or parcel of Lands containing by late survey one hundred and eighty acres of the
same more or less it being part of the Lands formerly belonging to Samuel Francis Esq
and a part of Lot No 1 which Lot was drawn by Samuel Francis Jr and sold to William Francis his
which deed and the Commissioners report will fully shew the boundaries together with the all &
singular thoughts members and appurtenances therunto belonging and the recesses of the
remainders issues and profits thereof We have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land
and all and singular the premises hereby bargained and sold or mentioned or intimated
to be unto us and every of his rights members and assigns to the only proper heirs of the
said Salathiel Francis and his heirs forever and the said Thomas Moore and Sally
his wife warrant and forever defend the premises aforesaid unto the said Salathiel
Francis his heirs and assigns forever against all and every person or persons whatsoever
