This Indenture made this 15th day of December in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred & forty two between George W Johnson and Bella his wife formerly Sally Daniel of the County of Southampton and State of North Carolina of the one part and Joseph M. Wallard of the County of Gloucester and State of Virginia of the other part testifying that the said George W Johnson and Bella his wife for an consideration of the sum of three hundred dollars to them or her hand paid the receipt whereof they do hereby acknowledge have bargained and sold and by these presents as and each of them took bargain and sold unto the said Joseph M. Wallard his heirs and assigns all their right title interest in a certain tract or parcel of Land (which still Daniel died seized and possessed with wife) and lying in the County of Southampton and bounded as follows to west beginning at a branch known by brandy bush running up said branch along William Dyer's line to a tree a corner tree in Joshua Cobbs line thence along said Cobbs line to a corner tree in Joseph M. Wallard's line thence along the said Wallard line to the Road thence along said Road to the beginning containing by estimation one hundred and six acres to the same mind or lip together with all and singular the appurtenances thereto belonging or appertaining or with the same used or enjoyed the revenue and accessions whatsoever and whatsoever and all trades or orchards ways and water courses and every part or parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land with the tenements thereon and all and singular the premises herein before mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold and every part and parcel thereof with every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Joseph M. Wallard his heirs and assigns forever and the said George W Johnson and Bella his wife for themselves and their heirs and assigns doth hereby covenant promise and grant to and unto the said Joseph M. Wallard his heirs and assigns forever and by these presents shall and will warrant and forever defend all right title interest claims or demands of all and every person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof In witness whereof the said George W Johnson and Bella his wife hath counterset their hands and affixed their seals this day and year above written signed sealed + delivered
