Blew or as land executed by saids attorney D. Blew and Sonnay to John Thomas and James Rochester Esqrs of Richard D. Blew debts for the sum of one hundred and thirty five dollars and
and due and payable on the 1st December 1822 and the said attorney D. Blew being willing and desirous to have the said Richard 13 Hiles from any saying or reprehending on account of his being security as aforesaid This Indenture Therefor witnesseth that the said attorney D. Blew for and consideration of the sum aforesaid and also for and in consideration of the sum of one dollar to her he has paid by the said Arthur Middleton the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have grants bargains and sold to do by these presents grant bargain and sell unto the said Arthur Middleton his heirs & assigns in Prima Fessa one chest drawer on top Gigg one small Ward one soft carpet four negroes named Sam edd Day and brother and Edmund and one black woman named Anna also five beds and furniture to have and to hold the said property herby Conveyed unto him the said Arthur Middleton his heirs and assigns upon this special trust and confidence that of the said Richard 13 Hiles shall suffer or be likely to suffer on account of his securityship aforesaid or towards or have the amount of the bond or any part thereof to pay that there are on that cap^t th shall and may be lawfull and of his freely indented and agreed by the parties to this present that the said Arthur Middleton his heirs Esqrs or adm^r shall at the request of the said Richard 13 Hiles his heirs &c sell the aforesaid property at Public Auctioneer as aforesaid advertising the time and place of such sale at the Court House or of the County and at as many other places as the said Arthur Middleton his heirs or administrators may deem advisable and at least twenty days previous to the day of sale and out of the proceeds of such sale first pay to the said Richard 13 Hiles his heirs or administrators the sum he may have paid or be likely to pay on account of his securityship aforesaid and also the cost and charges attending such sale and the surplus of any payment to the said attorney D.
