also five beds and furniture To have and to hold the said property fully conveyed unto him
the said John Abiddatton his heirs and assigns upon this special Trust and Confidence that
if the said Richard B. Kelle shall suffer or be likely to suffer on account of this security
afforesaid or have the amount of the bond or any part thereof to pay that then and in that case
he shall and may be lawfull and it is hereby understood and agreed by the parties to these
present that the said John Abiddatton his heirs Executors or admors shall at the request of the
said Richard B. Kelle his heirs or sell the aforsaid property at Publick Auction for cash & at
advertising the time and place of such sale at the Court House of this County and at as many other places
as the said John Abiddatton his heirs or administrators may deem advisable and at each being days previous to the
day of sale and out of the proceeds of such sale first pay to the said Richard B. Kelle his heirs or admors
for the sum he may have paid or be likely to pay on account of the security afforesaid and also the
