This Indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand Eight hundred and twenty two between Ludwell Williams of the County of Southampton and State of North Carolina of the one part and Thomas Worrell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part witnesses that the said Ludwell Williams for and secure redemption of the sum of five hundred and ninety dollars to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Worrell the receipt whereof the said Ludwell Williams doth acknowledge himself fully and amply satisfied and paid hath granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto Thomas Worrell to have and his heirs forever and certain tract or parcel of Land and premises situated lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of a certain containing by estimation Eighty acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a Post set in Thomas Worrell's line thence along Thomas Worrell's line to John Williams line thence along Williams line to Amos Stephens line thence along Stephens line to Thomas Worrell line in the corner right of Charles Stephenson thence along the corner right of said Land to John Worrell's line thence along Worrell's line to a point in Thomas Worrell's line and afterwards and thence along Thomas line to the first station together with all houses and houses edifices buildings Parks Gardens orchards crop meadows and water courses Whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said tract or parcel of Land and premises To have and to hold the said acre the said Thomas Worrell to have and his heirs forever and the said Ludwell Williams for himself his heirs Executors and assigns doth by these presents covenant and grant to and with the said Thomas Worrell his heirs and assigns that he the said Ludwell Williams will by these presents covenant and grant to and with the said Thomas Worrell his heirs and assigns that he will warrant and forever defend all right title claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof In witness whereof the said Ludwell Williams hath hereunto set his hand and affixed his seal this day and date before written signed sealed and declared in presence of
