The Indenture made this 15<sup>th</sup> day of December in the year of our Lord Christ One thousand Eight hundred and twenty two between Ludovic Williams of the County of Southampton and State of North Carolina of the one part and Thomas Worrell of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the other part witnesseth that the said Ludovic Williams for and in consideration of the sum of five hundred and ninety dollars to him in hand paid by the said Thomas Worrell the receipt whereof the said Ludovic Williams doth acknowledge himself fully and amply satisfied and paid heretofore granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargaine and sell unto Thomas Worrell to have and to use forever one certain tract or parcel of Land and premises situated lying and being in the County of Southampton and State of Virginia aforesaid containing by estimation Eight acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a Post rod in Thomas Stevens line thence along Stevens line to John Williams line thence along Williams line to Amos Stephens line thence along Stephens to Thomas Worrell land in the corner right of Charles Stephens line along the corner right of said Lands to John Mudenrods line thence along Mudenrods line to a post in Thomas Morris land aforesaid and thence along Morris line to the first station together with all houses and tenements Octopus building Barns orchard grape vines and water courses whatsoever belonging or in any wise appertaining to the said tract or parcel of Land and promises to have and to hold the said unto the said Thomas Worrell to him and his heirs forever and the said Ludovic Williams for giving his heirs Exec<sup>t</sup> and adm<sup>d</sup> d<sup>r</sup> by these presents covenant and grant to and with the said Thomas Worrell his heirs and assigns that he the said Ludovic Williams and by this present covenant and grant to and with the said Thomas Worrell his heirs and assigns that he will warrant and defend all right title claim or demand of any person or persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof.
