Wills & Undertakings made this 18<sup>th</sup> day of December in the Year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and thirty two Between the King, Sir Wm Parratt and Peter his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and John Spencer of the County and State aforesaid of the other part witnesseth that the said Wm Parratt and Peter his wife for and in consideration of the sum of two hundred and forty four dollars to them in hand paid by the said John Spencer the receipt whereof he doth acknowledge they the said Wm Parratt and Peter his wife have granted bargained and sold and by these presents doth grant bargain sell and Confer unto the said John Spencer his heirs and assigns forever one said tract or parcel of Land situate lying and being on the south side of Stannett River ~~containing~~ <sup>in the County of</sup> of Southampton aforesaid containing one hundred and a half acres to the land now or left thereon as follow to wit Beginning on the line of James Parratt due thence along the line to Col Stevens line thence along his line to Thomas Stevens line thence along his line to Ethan Stevens due line thence along his line to Thomas Stevens line aforesaid thence along the said Stevens line to the beginning and all the same and all the remainder and remainder unto Spence and service of the said premises and every part and parcel thereof and all the Estate right title interest claim and demand whatever of them the said Wm Parratt and Peter his wife of or to the land or tract or parcel of Land and of every part thereof to have and to hold the said tract or parcel of Land and all and singular the premises as above mentioned and every part thereof with the appurtenances unto the said John Spencer his heirs and assigns forever to the only intent and purpose of the said John Spencer his heirs and assigns forever and the said Wm Parratt and Peter his wife of the said tract or parcel of Land and premises and every part and parcel thereof against themselves and their heirs and against all and every person or persons whatsoever to the said John Spencer his heirs and assigns shall and will warrant and furnish defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Wm Parratt and Peter his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their seals the day & year above written signed sealed &
