This Indenture made this twenty second of November Eighteen hundred and twenty two
between Jordan Saynor of the first part Augustine Pope of the second part and Joseph Pope of the
third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia witnesseth that whereas the
said Augustine Pope bound at severly for the said Jordan Saynor by bond bearing date twenty two
of November Eighteen hundred and twenty two to see Draym Miller for the sum of two hundred and forty
two dollars and pay his costs also one other debt due to the said Robert Bond on demand the 25th December
last after which that the said Jordan Saynor hath for his consideration of the sum of one
dollar to him no hands paid by the said Joseph Pope hath granted bargained sold,
and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell unto the said Joseph Pope his
heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of Land, situate the Land
and plantation wherein the said Jordan Saynor now resides containing one hundred
and forty seven acres to the same more or less bounded by the well known standing
lines to lands for the following intent and purpose that he the said Joseph Pope
may and shall at any time hereafter being thereunto accouuted by either of the parties
sell at Publick sale for ready money sum of ten days from and after the said tract is
parcel of Land and out of the proceeds of such sale pay and satisfy each of the above
debt interest and costs of whatsoever kind of damages the said into effect and the
overplus of any sum so to the said Jordan Saynor given to his heirs and to the said Jordan
Saynor doth for himself his heirs and assigns doth forever warrant and defend the right
title of said Land unto the said Joseph Pope notwithstanding each of the parties had known
