Witnesseth that the said Samuel Collier for and in consideration of the sum of one hundred dollars unto him in hand paid by the said  
Henry Scott the receipt whereof the said Samuel Collier doth hereby acknowledge and himself fully satisfied and paid all of the said  
dolls by these presents against the said Henry Scott to the said Samuel Collier hath granted bargain and sale above and so offered  
and confirmed are by these presents to grant bargain and sell also and except and confirm unto the said Henry Scott one certain  
tract of Land containing by estimation forty acres more or less enclosing all the lands lying and being on the south side of the  
road belonging to the said Samuel Collier desired to him by Samuel Collier last will and testament to his son Charles Collier  
reference being that he hath well more fully agreed and made as follows to wit Beginning at the south field road leading to Scowles  
Corner of Charles Collier and Henry Scott lying thence to a corner of John York and Henry Scott thence up the said York  
line to Charles home door the said road to the beginning including the aforesaid lands subject to the same and with all houses walls  
and every trees and every appurtenances thereto belonging or in any way appertaining unto the rearways and rearways annexes;  
remainder and remainder lands of acres and 100 rods to Henry and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the said bargain  
and promises with the appurtenances unto the said Henry Scott the time and day of payment and the said Charles Collier  
testimonieth the terms and conditions the said bargain and promises and compact thereon passed between him with all the  
aforesaid Henry Scott his heirs and assigns do in every power and power whatsoever
