This Indenture made this fourth day of February in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and
twenty three between Miles Tabor of the one part and Henry Connel of the other part witnesseth that the said Miles
Tabor for and consideration of the sum of two hundred and seventy four dollars unto him on hand paid by the said
Henry Connel his receipt whereof the said Miles Tabor doth hereby acknowledge and himself fully satisfied and paid
and of the said debt to these presents against the said Henry Connel They the said Miles Tabor hath granted bargained
and sold aland unperfected and unconfirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell all and every part thereof and confirm unto
the said Henry Connel one certain tract plantation or parcel of land containing by estimation one hundred and twelve
acres being the same more or less lying and being situated in the County of Southampton and bounded by the lands
of Etheldreda Tabor Miles Tabor John Tabor Henry Gardner and others beginning at a small black gum standing
in the sugar hemp swamp at Etheldreda Tabor's house of the said black gum extending thence a white
oak in Miles Tabor's line thence running thence due south to Henry Gardner's line from H. Gardner's line to
John Gardner's line to the head of a small branch thence down Connel's line to the first stated meeting all together
112 acres by a late survey it being part of the lands devised by Etheldreda Tabor deceased in her last will and testament
to her son Miles Tabor reference being thereto had and made fully appeared unto all honest and ready ways unto
and every appearance thereof belonging or in anywise appertaining with the residue and remainder remainder
remained and remained unto her and profits thereof and every part and parcel thereof to have and to hold the
said bargained premises with the appurtenances unto the said Henry Connel his heirs and assigns forever and the
said Miles Tabor for himself his heirs and administrators the said bargained premises and every part
thereof unto all their appearances clear exempt and secure from all claim or other encumbrance whatsoever

dollars to her to hand paid by the said William Ellis after delivery of this present the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged she the said Eliza Vaughn for herself her heirs and assigns hath granted
bargained and sold released and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and sell all and every part thereof
unto the said William Ellis his heirs and assigns forever all the claim right title or interest in right of dower (whatsoever)
which she the said Eliza Vaughn hath in or to any certain tract of Land containing two hundred and eighty one and a
half acres which was held by her late husband the aforesaid Elizur Baughan and conveyed to the said William
Ellis by deed under the hand and seal of him the said Elizur Baughan which deed bears date the tenth day of
November one thousand Eight hundred and nineteen and is duly recorded in the County Court of Southampton
