This Indenture made this fourth day of January in the Year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty three between Ables Tarrow of the one part and Henry Sewer of the other part Witnesseth That this said Ables Tarrow has in consideration of the sum of two hundred and seventy four dollars unto him on hand paid by the said Henry Sewer the receipt whereof the said Ables Tarrow doth hereby acknowledge and himself fully satisfied and paid and of the said debt by these presents acquit the said Henry Sewer They the said Ables Tarrow hath granted bargained and sold all and sold unto the said Henry Sewer one certain tract plantation or parcel of land situate in the County of Southampton and bounded by the said of Ethelred Tarrow Ables Tarrow John Pick Henry Barrows and others beginning at a small black gum standing in the swampy marsh stream at Ethelred Tarrow line thence of the said stream the various courses there is a white oak and Ables Tarrow line thence running thence due south thence to Henry Barrows line from H.
