and thirty two between Thomas Howard and Elizabeth Howard his wife both of the County of Southampton date of residence
and parish of Saint Sacks of the one part and Joseph Toph of the same County date and parish of the other part
Witnesseth that the said Thomas Howard and Elizabeth his wife for and in consideration of the sum of nine hundred
and five dollars current money of Virginia to them in hand paid by the said Joseph Toph the full receipt whereof
the said Thomas Howard and Elizabeth his wife with acknowledge themselves fully and amply satisfied and have
hath granted bargain sold aliened conveyed and confirmed and by these presents doth grant bargain and
sell unto the said Joseph Toph to him and his heirs forever one certain tract or piece of Land and premises situate
lying and being in the County State and parish aforesaid and on the south side of a highway then near the town of James
and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a small water hole a new corner between the said Thomas Howard and
bordered which field standing in a small branch near a ditch thereabouts 19 6 1/4 pole to a small piece a corner in
