Pate his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of land lying in Southampton County and containing seventy three acres and the same more or less and bounded by the lands of George Tarrant Benjamin Ingold Richardson Prince and James Hudson and lying on the south side of the highway except it have and to hold the said land unto the firmest indentment and all and singular other the premises before mentioned or intended to be sold and every part and parcel thereof to the said Alexander P. Pate his heirs and assigns forever and for the only proper use and behoof of the said Alexander P. Pate and his heirs forever and the said John Prince and his heirs and assigns the said land with all and singular the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Alexander P. Pate his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of him the said John Prince or his heirs or assigns or any person or persons whatsoever shall call and do forever vacant and defend by these presents binding himself the said John Prince have himself set his hand and seal the day and year above written
