C. Jones of said County in Term of Court held at or before the ending and delivery of these presents
I have receipt whereof the said Henry Jones do hereby acknowledge have granted bargained and sold unto the said Thomas C. Jones
do grant bargain and sell unto the said Thomas C. Jones his Executors admors and assigns all the good things his stuff implements
stock of all kinds and furniture which I the said Henry Jones may have in possession remainder or reversion in my death
in hand and to hold unto the said good things his stuff stock and furniture and other the premises as aforesaid
above mentioned bargained and sold or intended to be to the said Thomas C. Jones his Executors admors and assigns
and assigns forever And I the said Henry Jones for myself my heirs Executors and admors all and singular the said good
things the said Thomas C. Jones his Executors admors and assigns against me the said Henry Jones my heirs Executors and assigns and
against all and every other person and persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents
in witness whereof I the said Henry Jones hath hereunto set my hand and seal this 24th day of January 1833

This Indenture made this 24th day of November in the year of our said Lord one thousand eight hundred and
twenty two between William Jones the debtor of the first part William Griffiths trustee of the second part and Allen
Edwards creditor of the third part all of the County of Southampton parish of Allington and State of Virginia doth
the said William Jones is duly indebted to the said Allen Edwards in the sum of fifty dollars to be paid on the 1st day
of January 1833 as by a bond bearing date on the 21st day of November 1832 more fully appears which is set into the legal contract
thereon according the said William Jones is duly and lawfully bound for the performance whereof that for and
in consideration of the premises and also for the further consideration of one dollar of lawful money of Virginia to the
said William Griffiths in hand paid by the said William Griffiths trustee at or before the ending and delivery of
these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said William Griffiths trustee granted bargained and sold
confirmed and by these presents doth give grant bargain and sell unto the said William Griffiths his heirs and
assigns forever the following personal and real estate and furniture one horse three head of cattle nine head of
hogs and twelve barrels of Long corn to have and to hold the aforesaid maner property unto the said William
Griffiths his heirs Executors admors and assigns forever to the use purpose and behoof of the said William Griffiths his
heirs Executors admors and assigns forever and the said William Jones for himself his heirs Executors admors doth hereby consent
promise and grant to and with William Griffiths his heirs Executors admors and assigns forever in manner and form follow-
ing that is to say that the said William Jones his heirs Executors admors the aforesaid mentioned property being conveyed
unto the said William Griffiths his heirs Executors admors and assigns against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant
and forever defend by these presents upon that covenant that the said William Griffiths his heirs Executors admors shall
permit the said William Jones to remove any part or parts of the property hereby conveyed and take the profits thereof
until default be made in the payment of the said sum of fifty dollars with the legal interest thereon and then
upon the further trust that the said William Griffiths his heirs Executors admors and assigns shall and will in case of
the happening of such default of payment as he may think just or the said Allen Edwards his heirs Executors admors
and assigns shall request sell the aforesaid mentioned property or as much thereof as will be sufficient for the full paid
of satisfying the aforesaid sum of fifty dollars with the legal interest thereon to the highest for money at public
auction after having paid the time and place of sale as the own discretion and give ten days notice thereof at the
least house door of the aforesaid County and at as many other public places as necessary and out of the money arising
from the sale shall after satisfying the charges thereof and all other expenses attending the sale of the same then
pay to the said Allen Edwards his heirs Executors admors and assigns the sum of fifty dollars with the legal interest thereof
and the balance of any shall pay to the said William Jones his heirs Executors admors and assigns but of the whole of the said sum
of fifty dollars with the lawful interest thereon shall be paid off and discharged to the said Allen Edwards his heirs
Executors admors or assigns on or before the first day of January 1833 when the same is payable so that in default of
payment to make then this Indenture to be void
