In the Clerk's office the 15th September 1822 This Indenture was proved by the oath of Joseph D. Glaze and James North two of its witnesses thence and continued and in the Clerk's office the 30th January 1823 This Indenture as aforesaid was (being proved by the oath of John Adams and together with the certificate therein contained) confirming the acknowledgment and being in execution of James North wife of Jesse North parties hereto and admitted to record and at a Court held for the purpose of the County of Southampton on the 17th February 1823 This Indenture and certificate aforesaid were ordered upon the proceedings of the day

This Indenture made this 9th day of November 1822 Between John Prince Richardson Prince William Prince and William Prince of the one part and Joseph of the second part and William D. Browne of the third part Whereas the said James of the first part is indebted to the said Browne of the third part in the amount of ten obligations for sundry debts and eight dollars due the 7th instant which he has agreed to secure him in consideration of the premises and of one dollar to them in hand paid by the said Joseph the receipt of which is acknowledged the said persons of the first part have bargained sold given and granted and by these presents do bargain sell give and grant to the said Joseph all the Land of which they are now seigns and proposed lying on and contiguous to the said land line between the Counties of Sussex and Southampton past being in each County and which they severally possess by inheritance from their father and also all the Slaves which they or either of them at this time severally have or possess together with the Trade of horses cattle sheep and hogs and also their share of interest in what lands or any other business in there and to hold the said Land Slaves and other estate to the said Joseph his heirs and assigns forever he Trust however that the said Joseph will permit them severally to retain possession of the said Slaves and other estate until the full payment of the said debt and interest they or either of them shall be obliged to the exchange the said claim of not more or otherwise the said Browne his heirs and assigns shall require the said Joseph or his heirs or assigns to execute the said Trust as to pay the said debt and costs that the said Joseph shall (in payment of said release his debt or assigns shall after having given ten days notice of the day of payment of said debt and interest to the said Browne and other estate of the said debt and interest and discharge the costs attending the execution of the said Trust and pay or in the residue or in his hands to the said persons of the first part or to such of them whose particular properties may have been selected to be sold as aforesaid and upon the further Trust that of the said persons of the first part shall themselves or either of them pay the said debt that then this Indenture is to be deemed null and void otherwise it remains in full force and virtue in testimony whereof we have hereunto signed our names and affixed our seals this day and date above written
