granted and confirmed and by these presents do bargain sell grant and confirm to the said John Clawd three
negro slaves one fellow named Peter one woman Edith and one girl named Rachel also all my stock of every
description including Horses cattle sheep hogs and also all my houses hold and kitchen furniture plantation
woods etc to have and to hold the said negro slaves and above mentioned property and the full use and
enjoyment thereof to the only purpose and behoof of him the said John Clawd his heirs
and assigns forever and I the said William Clawd for myself my heirs and assigns do give warrant and
warrant to the said John Clawd his heirs and assigns against one the said above mentioned
negro slaves and other property to the said John Clawd his heirs and assigns against one the said
William Clawd my heirs and assigns and against all and every other person and persons or their
heirs and assigns and forever defend by these presents binding otherwise I have hereunto
set my hand and affixed my seal this 15th day of November in the year of our Lord 1822

This Indenture made this 20th day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty
three by and between Briton Brite and companion his wife of Southampton County wife of the one part
and James Edwards of the same County and state of the other part containing that the said Briton Brite
and companion his wife for and in consideration of the sum of fifty dollars to them in hand paid before
the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is acknowledged they the said Briton
Brite and companion his wife have granted bargained sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents
do grant bargain sell and confirm unto him the said James Edwards his heirs and assigns forever their interest
in a certain piece or lot of land containing one acre more or less being on the east side of roadway six or six
and a half acres being bounded as follows viz Beginning at a cypress corner tree near the mouth of
the said roadway but running thence down the river to a white oak thence to an Elm parallel with the
river thence up the river to the said cypress the first corner tree is to have and to hold the said lot of land
together with its appurtenances to him the said James Edwards his heirs and assigns forever and they the
said Briton Brite and companion his wife for themselves their heirs and assigns do and will by these
presents warrant and defend the bargained premises against the lawful claim or claims of all and
every person whatsoever to him the said James Edwards and to his heirs and assigns forever in witness
whereof they the said Briton Brite and companion his wife have hereunto set their hands and affixed their
