This Indenture made this 18th February in the year said one eight hundred and nineteen between Abraham Williams and Rebecca Williams his wife of the first part and Arthur Williams of the second part witnesseth that the said Abraham Williams and Rebecca his wife for and in consideration of the sum of fifteen dollars consideration of bargain and sale by the said Arthur Williams the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have granted bargained and sold to said Arthur Williams confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain and sell alien enfeoff and confirm unto the said Arthur Williams his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Southampton and containing ten and a half acres by late survey it being a part of the tract known in our law and out of of the south end of said land by a line running east and west together with the appurtenances thereto or in anywise appurtenant and the revenue and revenues some interest rents issues and profits of the said premises and forever part and parcel thereof and also all the estate right title interest claim and demand whatsoever of them the said Abraham Williams and Rebecca his wife of or and to the said tract or parcel of land and premises and every part thereof to have and to hold to the said tract of land and premises and every part and parcel thereof with the appurtenances unto the said Arthur Williams his heirs his assigns to the only proper use and behoof of him the said Arthur Williams his heirs his assigns forever and the said Abraham Williams and Rebecca his wife hereunto and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land and premises with its appurtenances unto the said Arthur Williams his heirs his assigns against the claim and demand of all persons whatever shall and mile demand and by these presents forever defend in witness whereof the said parties parties have hereunto set their hand and seals this 18th above say an a date
