This Indenture made this 10th day of January in the year of our Lord Christ one thousand eight hundred and twenty three Between Abigail Griffen and Elizabeth his wife of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Amos Solomon of the same County and State of Virginia of the other part Witnesseth that the said Abigail Griffen and Elizabeth his wife in consideration of the sum of three hundred and fifty dollars of lawful money of this Commonwealth to them in hand paid by the said Amos Solomon at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged Have bargained and sold and by these presents doth bargain and sell unto the said Amos Solomon his heirs and assigns a certain tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the County and Parish of said containing by estimation ten acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows Beginning at a gum in the branch called Gravelly Run thence a line of marked trees through a line to a lightwood Post a corner of Joseph Hanigans said land thence a line of marked trees to a pine in said Hanigans' line thence a line of marked trees and good plants in the open ground thence a line of marked trees to a gum on the aforesaid Gravelly Run a corner of said land thence down the said branch to the first Station together with all house and house hold fixtures buildings yards gardens orchards any notes and other contents together with all and singular the profits Commodities Rents tithes and appurtenances therunto belonging or any part or parcel thereof to have and to hold the said ten acres of Land unto the premises herein before mentioned and every part and parcel thereof unto the said Amos Solomon his heirs and assigns forever to and for the heirs proper and of them the said Amos Solomon his heirs and assigns forever and the said Abigail Griffen and Elizabeth his wife for themselves their heirs the said ten acres and unto all the appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said Amos Solomon his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Abigail Griffen and Elizabeth his wife or either of them their heirs and of all and every other person or persons whatsoever shall and will claim and forever defend by these presents In witness whereof the said Abigail Griffen and Elizabeth his wife have hereunto set their names and seals the day and year first within written
