Frequent and Edith his wife for and in consideration of the sum of ten thousand five hundred and twenty five dollars to them in hand paid by the said Thomas Abner Lewis first an before the executing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged they the said Lewis C. Frequent and Edith his wife for themselves their heirs executors and administrators have granted bargain sold sold aliened and confirmed and by these presents do grant bargain sell alien and confirm unto him the said Thomas Abner Lewis and to his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or piece of land lying in the County of Southampton in the better district of Abbeysburg Parish bounded by the lands of Abraham L. Lindsay that of Symon Vaughan and Edith John Arles James Edwards Wm. Abner and Elias Edwards. It being the tract of land which the said Lewis Frequent purchased from the said Simon Abner Lewis as appears by the said Abner Lewis deed which is recorded in the County Court of Southampton and which from a conveyance of the same made by James Sims Esqr is mentioned in the said deed from Simon Abner Lewis as containing three hundred and twenty one and a half acres but which from a more recent and correct survey is found really to contain only one hundred and seventy eight and one fifth acres to have and to hold the said tract of land with all and singular the rights appurtenant thereto and appurtenances to the same belonging in form or out of the same in any manner arising or hereafter to him the said Simon Abner Lewis his heirs and assigns forever. And they the said Lewis Frequent and Edith his wife for themselves their heirs and such of their heirs executors and administrators as by their parents warrant and will forever defend the said bargain and promises against the lawfull claim or demand of all and every person or persons whatsoever to him the said Simon Abner Lewis and to his heirs and assigns forever.
