This Indenture made and entered into this thirteenth day of February One thousand eight hundred and twenty three between Richard Hines of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Wm. Womble of the aforesaid County and State of the other part witnesseth that the said Richard Hines for and consideration of the sum of One hundred and seven dollars and fifty cents good and lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Wm. Womble the receipt whereof the said Richard Hines doth acknowledge himself amply satisfied hath given and bargained and sold unto his presents with quo grant long and well unto the said Wm. Womble and his heirs forever one tract of land and premises being his lot No. 2 in the division of the lands of Benjamin Allen deceased lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by estimation forty seven acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit beginning at a small pine tree corner of Mitchell's estate home along said Estate line to a run corner made in lot No. 1 thence along the dividing line lot No. 1 to a run corner made in lot No. 1 & lot 4 thence along the dividing line of lot 2 and 3 to a red oak a corner of James Crofton and thence to the beginning together with all houses and hundred feet of buildings upon land, and orchard and water courses whatsoever belonging or in anywise appertaining to the said tract of land to there and to hold the same unto the said Wm. Womble to have and to use forever and the said Benjamin Hines for himself his heirs to and by these presents warrant and defend the same against the lawful claim or claims of himself his heirs and every other person whatsoever he introp whereof the said Richard Hines had premises so his hand and seal the day and year as above written

This Indenture made this 17th day of December 1822 Between Robert Gossom of the County of Southampton of the one part James Dillards of the County of Suffolk of the other part and Henry Scott of the County of Southampton of the said part that whereas the said Henry Scott by his act dated the 17th day of November in the year of our Lord 1819 and admitted to record January 17th 1820 in the County Court of Southampton on oath to swear the hazard of his head that he had given to the said James Dillards the sum of two hundred dollars due on the 25th day of December 1820 one thousand and two hundred and twenty five dollars due on the 25th day of December 1821 and one thousand dollars due the 25th day of December 1822 which sum was due to Henry Scott with the said James Dillards as the said James Dillards having and the said Henry Scott in a note to the memory and bare memory the said James Dillards in the County of Suffolk his County in the above mentioned acts the bonds which he the said James Dillards purchased of Benjamin in Scott containing by estimation three thousand acres by reference to the said act were fully paid and the said James Dillards in the whole making them three thousand acres having been fully paid by the said Henry Scott to the said Henry Scott to the said James Dillards
