This Indenture made this 24th day of December in the year of our Lord 1822 between James Comrie the debtor of the first part and Abigail Syng Trustee of the second part and Lawrence Syng of the third part all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia whereas the said James Comrie is justly indebted unto the said Lawrence Syng on the first sum of ten dollars due by note or bond bearing date 26th day of December 1822 with interest thereon till paid which the said James Comrie is willing and desirous to draw on this Indenture notwithstanding that for and in consideration of the premises also for further sum of one dollar of Current money of Virginia to the said James Comrie or his heirs paid by the said Lawrence Syng as or before the making and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged by the said James Comrie hath given grants bargained and sold released and confirmed by these presents to the said Abigail Syng her heirs and assigns the said estate of Lawrence Syng and assigns forever the following property to wit one bed and pippys 1 Lombt one feather bed and furniture on chest and Carpenter tools one pot stellit and spiss one spinning wheel one pair Cart wharfe a punc of plank corn and fascine with all the interest or right title claim and demand of the above mentioned property to have and to hold the said lands hereby granted or intended to be granted hereby Conveyed unto the said Abigail Syng his heirs Exec adm and assigns forever and the said James Comrie for himself his heirs Exec adm and assigns do hereby Covenant promise and agree to and with the said Abigail Syng his heirs for in manner and form following that is to say that the said James Comrie his heirs Exec and assigns the aforesaid property unto the said Abigail Syng his heirs Exec and assigns against all persons whatsoever shall and will warrant and forever defend by these presents upon trust nevertheless that the said Abigail Syng for [REDACTED] his assigns shall present the said James Comrie to remain in quiet and peaceful possession of the said property hereby Conveyed and take the profits thereof to his own use until default be made in the payment of the said sum of ten dollars either in whole or part and then upon the further trust that the said Abigail Syng his heirs Exec and assigns shall and will do soon after the happening of such default of payment as he the said Exec and assign may think proper or the said Lawrence Syng his heirs Exec and assigns shall request sell the before mentioned property or such part thereof as the said shall think proper or sufficient for his purpose and shall prefer to sell to the highest bidder for ready money at publick auction after giving notice of the time and place of sale at his own discretion and giving ten days notice thereof at the Court House door of this County and as may other publick place as may think proper or some Court day previous to the day of sale and as out of the money arising from said sale after satisfying the charges thereof and the other deficiencies about the said land shall pay to the said Lawrence Syng his heirs Exec and assigns the before mentioned sum of ten dollars with
