This Indenture made and entered into the twentieth day of February Eighteen hundred and twenty three between Thomas C. Jones of the first part Auctioneer and Advertiser of the second part and Simon Appleton and Samuel S. Appletonburg of the third part whereas the said Simon Appleton is decedent to the said Thomas C. Jones for his carrying the same for the United States equal to Contract with the said United States commencing the first day of January last past and the said Samuel S. Appletonburg being his security on the same as well as for the payment of several sums of money particularly a certain sum to Simon Appletonburg made to Samuel Appleton of the same place and on the said Samuel Sutherland representative of Richmond Delaware and the said Thomas C. Jones being desirous of releasing said Appletonburg against any debt by reason of said decedent's and likewise to release said Appletonburg against any debt by reason of the above mentioned obligations as well as on all and every other debt in which the said Appletonburg is or may be bound for the payment of money on account of said Thomas C. Jones then for and in consideration of the premises and also for the further covenants of and in favor of said Appletonburg in these parts to the said Thomas C. Jones by the said Auctioneer Advertiser he the said Thomas C. Jones have given granted bargained and sold and by these presents do give grant bargain and sell unto Auction Advertiser later on certain tract or parcel of land containing one hundred and fifty acres being the tract whereon the said Thomas C. Jones now resides to him his heirs and assigns forever all the single gipsy and harrow one horse mow and ten long fences to have and the said premises and appurtenances with the gipsy and harrow and fences with them the said Auction Advertiser his heirs and assigns forever upon trust nevertheless that the said Auction Advertiser will permit the said Thomas C. Jones his heirs and assigns to have and enjoy the benefit thereof in all such time as the said Appleton or the said Appletonburg may have retained and enjoy by the aforesaid undertaking as security either for the payment of damages for the non performance of his Contract or by the payment of any sum or sums for which the aforesaid Appletonburg is bound and then upon this further trust that the said Auction Advertiser will do soon after the payment any money made by the said Appleton or the said Appletonburg by reason of their several undertakings and upon the request of them the said Appleton and Appletonburg or either of them proceed to sell the said tract of land for cash to the highest bidder on the premises or do much thereof as may be necessary to indemnify the said Appleton and the said Samuel Sutherland and his wife in and for the amount of any sum or sums for which the said Samuel Sutherland and after payment in the expenses of this trust and indemnifying the said Appleton and the said Appletonburg from the balance of any sum or sums the said Thomas C. Jones do hereby release and discharge him and his heirs and assigns before named
