This Indenture made and entered into second day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty five Between Alexander Harvey and Sarah Standing his wife of the one part and Lewis C Tregant of the other part witnesseth that the said Alexander Harvey and Sarah Standing his wife in consideration of their true and lawful debts and money here bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them doth bargain and sell unto the said Lewis C Tregant his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or piece of Land lying situated and being in the County of Southampton containing by recent survey two hundred and ninety one acres more or less and bounded as follows on the east by the lands of Thomas Emmerling South by the said land belonging to the Estate of Griffin Smith west by the little Swamp North by a part of said Swamp and the lands belonging to Sarah Standing with the mansion and numerous remains and remains of grange and other out of hand and perfect and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract and parcel of Land with the tenements thereunto and all and singular the premises herebefore mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold with every part and parcel thereof and every of their rights members and appurtenances unto the said Lewis C Tregant his heirs and assigns forever and the said Alexander Harvey and Sarah Standing his wife hereunto and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Lewis C Tregant his heirs and assigns free from the claim or claims of them the said Alexander Harvey and Sarah Standing his wife for themselves or either of them their heirs or either of their heirs and of all and every person whatsoever shall make and do present and defense by these presents In witness whereof they set their hands and seals the day and Year before written.
