This Indenture made and entered into second day of December in the year one thousand eight hundred and twenty four Between Alexander Harvey and Sarah his wife the one part and Lewis C Esq of the other part witnesseth that the said Alexander Harvey and Sarah his wife in consideration of their true and lawful amount money here bargained and sold and by these presents do and each of them do sell bargain and sell unto the said Lewis C Esq and assigns forever on certain tract or pieces of Land lying situated and being in the County of Southampton containing by recent survey five hundred and ninety one acres more or less and bounded as follows on the east by the lands of Samuel Esq bounded by the said land belonging to the Estate of Griffin Esq west by the little Swamp North by a part of said Swamp and the lands belonging to Josiah Howard with the mansion and remainder and remainder of ground and other parts of land and profits and every part and parcel thereof To have and to hold the said tract and parcel of Land with the tenements heretofore and all and singular the premises heretofore mentioned or intended to be bargained and sold with every part and parcel thereof and every of their right members and appurtenances unto the said Lewis C Esq and assigns forever and the said Alexander Harvey and Sarah his wife furthermore and their heirs the said tract or parcel of land with the premises and appurtenances before mentioned unto the said Lewis C Esq and assigns forever and the said Alexander Harvey and Sarah his wife themselves or either of them their heirs and of all and every person what so ever shall come and do waivant and defense by these presents In witness whereof they set their hands and seal the day and Year before written
