This Indenture made and entered into on the 17th day of November in the year of our Lord Christ 1833 By and between Rachel Williams George Williams and Jane Williams wife of said George Williams all of the County of Southampton and State of Virginia of the one part and Jacob Barnes of the aforesaid County and State of the other part Witnesseth that the said Rachel Williams George Williams and Jane his wife have for and in consideration of the sum of Eighty two dollars Seventy Cents Current Money of Virginia this Commencement to them in hand paid by the said Jacob Barnes at or before the executing and delivery of these presents the full receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged granted bargained and sold and by these presents do grant bargain and sell unto the said Jacob Barnes and to his heirs forever all that right little interest and Estate which they the said Rachel Williams George Williams and Jane his wife have in and to one certain Tract or parcel of Land lying and being in the aforesaid County of Southampton and Parish of Saint Lukes Containing by estimation three acres is the said one acre and bounded as follows First Beginning at a Corner of John Hicks land at the first road and a run Corner Made in the said Rachel Williams George Williams and Jane his wife line thence along the said John Hicks line of marked trees nearly a north course to a small Green pine Corner of said John Hicks in north Top; thence along said John Hicks line of marked trees nearly an Eastwardly Course to Benjamin Morris line thence along said Benjamin Morris line of marked trees nearly a south westerly Course to a large Green pine Corner of Thomas Hensons in said Benjamin Morris line also a run Corner made between said Rachel Williams George Williams and Jane his wife and said Jacob Barnes thence along a run line of marked trees made between said Rachel Williams George Williams and Jane his wife and said Jacob Barnes North 88 Degrees West 144 Poles to a small black oak a run Corner of said Rachel Williams George Williams and Jane his wife thence along said run line of marked trees nearly a south Course to the aforesaid first road thence up said first road North 67 degrees West one pole to the 1st Station together with all its Commodities Emoluments Appurtenances and appurtenances to the said lands in any use or manner belonging to them the said Jacob Barnes and his heirs forever for them the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns To have and to hold the before described tract or parcel of lands forever from the claim or claims of either of them the said Rachel Williams George Williams and Jane his wife or either of them heirs and also every person or persons whomsoever and they the said Rachel Williams George Williams and Jane his wife do hereby declare their and each of their heirs heirs and assigns warrant and forever defend the right and title of the said tract or parcel of lands insofar as respects to them the said Jacob Barnes his heirs and assigns forever and also against the lawful claims or claims of all and every persons claiming or demanding the same or any part or parcel thereof by writing either of them the said Rachel Williams George Williams and Jane his wife have themselves set their hands and affixed their seals this day and date first written on this
