Brett of the other part witnesseth that the said Bryan in County for use in consideration of the sum of Six Thousand and twenty one dollars and fifty cents in hand paid by the said Archibald E. Brett before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Bryan in County doth hereby acknowledge the said Bryan in County hath granted bargained and sold to the said Archibald E. Brett his heirs and assigns forever on certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Southampton containing two hundred and fifty nine acres more or less it being the tract or parcel of land that Septo Carroll and wife and offspring of and devised to be sold by his last will and testament and bounded by the lands of John G. Way James Vaughan George Branch Abingdon Edwards Doctor G. Brattle and James Brattle and revenue and services remainder and remainder rents and services of said land and premises and also all the estate right title interest and claims and demands of him the said Benjamin Branch his heirs of in and to the said land and every part thereof to have and to hold the said land and premises with the appurtenances therin before mentioned unto the said Archibald E. This Indenture made this 1st day of March Eighteen hundred and Twenty three between Edwards Taylor of the County of Southampton and of the parish of Abingdon of the one part and Septo Vick of the same County and Parish of the other part witnesseth that the said Edwards Taylor for and consideration of the sum of Nine Thousand and twenty five dollars gold and lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said Septo Vick the receipt whereof the said Edwards Taylor doth acknowledge fully and ample satisfaction and has fully granted bargained sold alined enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents hath granted bargained and sold unto the said Septo Vick one certain tract or parcel of land and premises situated lying and being in the County of Southampton containing by survey one hundred acres to the same more or less and bounded as follows that Beginning at a tree in Sally Edwards' field running thence down Robert Clark's line to John George's line thence along the said George's line to a place on Septo Vick's line thence along the said Vick's line to the front station together with all houses and barns building &c yard gardens orchard meadow &c whatsoever belonging to him the said Edwards Taylor and all the right title interest and claim thereupon unto thence and seal the day and date above written
