This Indenture made and entered into this seventh day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand Eight hundred and thirty three Between Benjamin Benjamin in Council of Somersetshire County of the one part and Archibald C. Biddle of the other part Witnesseth that the said Benjamin Biddle for and in consideration of the sum of one thousand and seventy one dollars and fifty Cents in hand paid by the said Archibald C. Biddle before the Sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof the said Benjamin Benjamin doth hereby acknowledge the said Benjamin in Council hath granted bargained and sold to the said Archibald C. Biddle his heirs and assigns forever one certain tract or parcel of land lying and being in the County of Somersetshire containing ten hundred and fifty nine acres more or less situate being the tract or parcel of land that John Carver and his heirs and assigns doth and doeth to be sold by his last will and testament and bequeathed to the said John C. Way James Nathaniel George Branch Anthony Edwards Walter Biddle and James Biddle and reversion and reversions remainder and remainders heirs and Services of said land and premises and also the estate right title interest and claim and demand of him the said Benjamin Biddle his heirs and assigns forever in respect whereof the said Benjamin in Council doth herewith set his hands and seal the day and date first above written signed sealed and delivered

Vapor to Field

This Indenture made this 14th day of March Eight hundred and thirty three Between Edward Vapor of the County of Somersetshire and of the parish of Stutton of the one part and John Vick of the same County and Parish of the other part Witnesseth that the said Edward Vapor for and in consideration of the sum of Nine hundred and seventy five dollars good and lawful money of Virginia to him in hand paid by the said John Vick the receipt whereof the said Edward Vapor doth acknowledge hath well fully and amply satisfied and paid hath granted bargained sold aliened enfeoffed and confirmed and by these presents hath granted bargained and sold unto the said John Vick one certain tract or parcel of land and premises situate lying and being in the County of Somersetshire containing by survey one hundred acres be the same more or less and bounded as follows to wit Beginning at a stake in Edley Barrenes thence running thence down between Clarke line to John Dromp line thence along the said Dromp line to a stake in Edley Vicks line thence along the said Vicks line to the first station together with all houses and houses and all the good grasses meadows &c. whatsoever belonging to him the said Edward Vapor and all the right title interest and claim known and or unknown and all the appurtenances and all the appurtenances
